**REQUIRING ALL SINGLE MOTORCYCLE OWNERS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LAMUT, IFUGAO TO SECURE VERIFICATION OF IDENTIFICATION AND STICKERS AUTHENTICITY (VISA) CARD AND PROVIDING FUNDS, PRESCRIBING FEES, IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Municipality of Lamut is the Gateway of the Province of Ifugao and is adjacent to the province of Nueva Vizcaya where people may come and go.

There are numerous incidents of crimes against persons and property in our municipality and nearby municipalities which involve suspects riding in motorcycles or using motorcycles as their get-away vehicles. To pre-empt the commission of crimes in the municipality, this ordinance seeks to verify the identification of single motorcycle owners and the authenticity of their ownership documents.

The operation Verification of Identification and Stickers Authenticity (VISA) is also in support of the Oplan "RED EYE" of the Ifugao Police Provincial Office to neutralize motorcycle-riding criminals and effectively address theft of motorcycles.

This ordinance likewise aims to help owners of single motorcycle in case of accidents where the rider cannot be easily identified or does not carry documents for identification.

As prescribed by R.A 7160, also known as the Local Code of 1991, specifically Section 447 - the Sangguniang Bayan approves ordinances and pass resolutions necessary for an efficient municipal government, and in this connection shall maintain peace and order by enacting measures to prevent and suppress

lawlessness, disorder, riot, violence, rebellion or sedition and impose penalties for the violation of said ordinances

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Lamut, Ifugao in session duly assembled.

**SECTION 1 - TITLE.** An ordinance requiring all single motorcycle owners in the Municipality of Lamut, Ifugao to secure Verification of Identification and Stickers Authenticity (VISA) card and providing funds, prescribing fees, imposing penalties for violations thereof and for other purposes.

**SECTION 2 - COVERAGE.** Owners of privately owned single motorcycles in the Municipality of Lamut, Ifugao including those non-residents who has business in the Municipality or those individuals who have regular works and enter the Municipality regularly are required to secure VISA Cards for their single motorcycles with the Lamut Police Station.

**SECTION 3 - FEES.** The stickers and identification cards shall be charged from the owners/new owners a fee of One Hundred Pesos (P100.00) per unit and Fifty Pesos (P50.00) for renewal every year and shall be paid at the Municipal Treasury Office. An additional Fifty Peso (P50.00) shall be charged for replacement of lost or damaged VISA card.

**SECTION 4 - DEFINITION OF TERMS** as used in this ordinance.

**A. MOTORCYCLE/S** - shall mean a two-wheeled motor vehicle

**B. VERIFICATION OF IDENTIFICATION AND STICKER AUTHENTICITY (VISA)** - sticker to be designed by and issued by the Lamut Police Station after payment is made with the Municipal Treasury Office. Said stickers shall bear the first two (2) letters "LT" representing the municipality of Lamut and the last four (4) digits representing the number of the motorcycle

**C. VISA CARD-** is a card issued together with the visa sticker bearing the necessary information about the owner (name, address, cellphone number), a passport size identification picture, and details of information regarding the motorcycles (plate number, chassis number, engine number, model/make color and driver's license number)

**D. TIR-** Technical Information Report made on seized motorcycle signed by the corresponding officer and acknowledged by the motorcycle owner or the person apprehended

**E. MTO** -Municipal Treasury Office of Lamut

**F. MPOC** -Municipal Peace and Order Council

**SECTION 5 - IMPLEMENTATION**

**A.** Owners of single motorcycle shall secure a visa sticker and VISA card from the Lamut Police Station

**B.** Issued VISA cards shall be carried at all times by the owner while in transit in the Municipality of Lamut.

**C.** Visa sticker shall be attached to a conspicuous part of the motorcycle preferably on the right frontal portion of the motorcycle which can be readily accessible for inspecting officers.

**D. Owners shall be in possession of the following requirements:**

- (1.) Driver's License
- (2.) Official Receipt and Certificate of Registration Issued By Land Transportation Office
- (3.) 2 passport size id pictures
- (4.) Certificate from the company if the motorcycle is new or in the case of installment and unpaid units, a copy of the chattel mortgage
- (5.) for purchased units from private individual, the buyer or owner must present a notarized Deed of Sale
- (6.) Official Receipt from the Municipal Treasury Office must be presented before the issuance of VISA card and sticker

**E. The sticker shall be renewed every year.**

**F. The sticker is non transferrable.**

**G. In case the sticker and the card are lost, destroyed or stolen by another person, it shall be the duty of the owner to inform the Lamut Police Station.**

**SECTION 6 -PENAL PROVISION.** Owners of motorcycle caught or apprehended without the authorized stickers shall be penalized as follows:

- A. 1<sup>ST</sup>OFFENSE** - Fine of Two Hundred Pesos(P200.00)
- B. 2<sup>ND</sup> OFFENSE** - Fine of Four Hundred Pesos (P400.00)
- C. 3<sup>RD</sup> AND SUCCEEDING OFFENSES-** Fine of Eight Hundred Pesos (P800.00) and impoundment of the motorcycle vehicle at the Lamut Police Station, and imprisonment of three (3) days or both upon the discretion of a competent court.
- D.** Anyone found to have tampered, stolen or illegally transferred a sticker from one motorcycle to another shall be fined with One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00).

**SECTION 7 -FINAL DISPOSITION OF IMPOUNDED MOTORCYCLES AND ARRESTED PERSONS**

**A.** All confiscated motorcycles found in violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be impounded at the Municipal Police Station of Lamut and shall be released to the owner after payment of the fines prescribed herein and upon presentation by the owner of evidences of ownership thereof. However, an additional impounding fee in the amount of One Hundred Pesos (P100.00) per day after five (5) days upon impoundment shall be paid.

**B.** Recovered or carnapped motorcycle shall be turned over to the Philippine National Police of Lamut, Ifugao for proper action.

**C.** A Technical Inspection Report (ITR) shall be conducted for the seized motorcycle at the recovery site, and in the presence of any local government official (municipal/barangay) and/or any responsible citizen residing at the place of recovery who shall affix his/her signature on the temporary official receipt, except when there is highly reasonable ground for the non-availability

of a witness taking into consideration the time of seizure and the area of recovery.

**D.** The Chief of Police of Lamut, Ifugao shall render a spot report through chain of command and furnish copies of the said report to the Local Chief Executive, the MPOC, Sangguniang Bayan and after a motor vehicle was seized for violation of the provisions of this ordinance.

**E.** If a criminal complaint is filed relative to the recovery of a carnapped/stolen or impounded motorcycle, the investigator assigned on a case shall correspondingly request the concerned Highway Patrol Group, Regional or Provincial for the release thereof in favor of the rightful owner. In case there is an order from a competent court or from the prosecutor's office for the non-release of the motorcycle, the same shall not be released and withheld until revoked/reverted.

## **SECTION 8- MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS**

**A.** To hasten the implementation of this ordinance, the Municipal Treasury Office / its representative, in coordination with the Lamut Police Station, shall establish a one stop shop/counter to receive application for the registration and payments of the prescribed fees, verification of units and issuance of citation tickets.

**B.** The Lamut PNP or its representative shall be in charge of the design lay out of the VISA sticker to be forwarded to the Municipal Treasury Office and office of the Sangguniang Bayan.

**C.** The PNP shall maintain a database system that would have a master list of all VISA Card holders for the purpose of easy monitoring.

**SECTION 9 - DEPUTIZATION.** All members of the Lamut Police Station, specifically the uniformed personnel and the Public Order and Safety Aide shall be deputized by the Local Chief Executive to enforce this ordinance.

## **SECTION 10- FUNDING/APPROPRIATION**

The amount of Twenty Thousand Pesos (P20,000) shall be appropriated to implement the provisions of this ordinance.

## **SECTION 11- ACCRUAL OF FEES**

All fines collected in the implementation of this ordinance shall be divided into a ratio of 60:40, wherein 60% of the collected fines will go to the General Fund of the Local Government Unit of Lamut, and the 40% will go to the MOOE of the PNP.

## **SECTION 12 - REPEALING CLAUSE**

All municipal ordinances, resolutions, or any part or parts thereof which are hereby inconsistent with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

## **SECTION 13 - SEPARABILITY CLAUSE**

Should any provisions of this ordinance be declared invalid, the validity of the other provisions thereof shall be unaffected thereby.

**SECTION 14 EFFECTIVITY.** This ordinance shall take effect 60 days upon its approval.
