**DECLARING EVERY FIRST FRIDAY OF DECEMBER AS MUNICIPAL
VOLUNTEER WORKERS DAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LAMUT AND
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The International Volunteers Day (IVD) mandated by the UN General Assembly designated December 5 each year as a day to celebrate the power and potential of volunteer workers. It is viewed as an opportunity for volunteers to celebrate their efforts, to share their values, to raise awareness and gain understanding for the contributions they make in their communities.

The LGU recognizes the contributions of these volunteer workers as first responders or frontliners, the role they perform in public service delivery.

With the declaration of a Municipal Volunteer Workers Day, it seeks to provide a day of socialization to encourage intensive and active participation in government and non-government programs, projects, and activities concerning them.

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Lamut, Ifugao in session duly assembled:

SECTION 1 - TITLE. This ordinance shall be known as the Municipal Volunteer Workers Day Ordinance in the municipality of Lamut, Province of Ifugao.

SECTION 2. STATEMENT OF POLICY. It is a declared policy of the LGU to recognize the important role the Municipal Volunteer Workers play in the community as frontliners in public service through the celebration of Volunteer Workers Day every first Friday of December.

SECTION 3 – DEFINITION OF TERMS. As used in this ordinance, the following shall mean:

1. Municipal Volunteer Workers includes
 - a. Barangay Nutrition Scholars (BNS)
 - b. Barangay Health Workers (BHW)
 - c. Barangay Tanods
 - d. Barangay Day Care Workers (DCW)

SECTION 4. IMPLEMENTATION. There shall be a Steering Committee to be created to implement this Ordinance and may otherwise recommend other necessary implementing rules and regulations for the proper enforcement of this Ordinance. It shall be composed of the following:

Municipal Mayor or his representative
Municipal Social Welfare and Development Officer (MSWDO)
Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) or MLGOO
Municipal Health Officer (MHO)
Liga ng mga Barangay (LMB) President
Municipal Nutrition Action Officer (MNAO)

SECTION 5. PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES. Under the supervision of the Office of the Local Chief Executive, the celebration of the Municipal Workers Day shall include:

1. Creation of various committees. Committees such as Nomination, Selection and Awards, Programs, Finances shall be created from the different Municipal Volunteer Workers, in coordination with the LGU to ensure the successful conduct of the celebration.
2. Annual Search, recognition and awarding of the Most Outstanding BNS, BHW, Tanod, Daycare Worker in the Municipality of Lamut. The search shall be conducted accordingly.
 - 2.1. The nomination, judging and awarding activities in relation to the search for Most Outstanding Volunteer Worker shall be undertaken by the various committees assigned for each function
 - 2.2. The winners shall be awarded with a plaque of appreciation from the LGU and a cash prize.
3. Volunteer Worker's Day in the municipality. On this special day, there shall be various activities such as a program, presentation, games and other activities to be conducted. In case first Friday of December falls on a holiday, it shall be celebrated on the next regular working day.
4. Other relevant activities may also be designed subject to the availability of funds.

SECTION 6. FUNDING. The amount of Fifty Thousand Pesos (P50,000.00) shall be appropriated for the effective implementation of this ordinance.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE. All municipal ordinances, resolutions, or any part or parts thereof which are hereby inconsistent with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and availability of fund.
