**MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2018-18-12**

**GRANTING MATERNITY PACKAGE TO ALL PREGNANT MOTHERS WHO HAVE COMPLETED PRENATAL CARE SERVICES FROM THE RURAL HEALTH UNIT (RHU) AND/OR BARANGAY HEALTH STATIONS (BHS) WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LAMUT UPON DELIVERY**

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The Local Government Unit is called upon to implement Maternal Newborn Child Health and Nutrition (MNCHN) strategy of the Department of Health (DOH) with an end goal of improving women and child's health thereby decreasing maternal and neonatal mortality and reducing low birth weight cases.

Prenatal care reduces low birth weights among all pregnant women and that it conveys particular benefit to children born out of healthy mothers.

Direct evidence show that pregnant women who receive inadequate prenatal care are those at greater than average risk of a low birth weight delivery.

Efforts to reduce incidence of malnutrition among children caused by low birth weights, a commitment to enrolling all pregnant women in prenatal care is encouraged.

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Lamut, Ifugao in session duly assembled:

**SECTION 1. TITLE.** This Ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Granting Maternity Package to all pregnant women who have completed prenatal care services from the RHU and/or Barangay Health Stations (BHS) within the Municipality of Lamut."

**SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY** - It is a declared policy of the Municipality to implement Maternal and Child Health Care Program in order to ensure that the welfare and well-being of pregnant women, mothers, and newborn children shall be secured and enhanced.

**SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS.** As used in this Ordinance, the following shall mean:

- a. BEMONC facility - Basic Emergency Obstetric and Newborn Care facility that provides maternal and newborn services to pregnant women, staffed with

competent and trained personnel to attend to the needs of the mother and the newborn. It is a well-equipped birthing facility like those accredited Barangay Health Stations

- b. Maternal Care Package Fund - fund from Philhealth Corporation for Philhealth members and dependents who deliver at a Philhealth accredited facility
- c. Birthing facility - a facility where birth deliveries are duly attended by a skilled birth attendant, usually referred to health facilities duly licensed by DOH to assist normal deliveries
- d. Maternity kit - includes items contained in a kit for mother and child use after delivery
- e. Prenatal Care - refers to care of pregnant women having monthly prenatal visits from the first month to the seventh month of gestation, twice a month at eight month age of gestation and weekly during the ninth month of gestation

#### **SECTION 4. COMPLETE PRENATAL CARE PROVISIONS**

- 4.1. Pregnant mothers shall undergo prenatal care services which shall consist of the following within the entire pregnancy but not limited to:
  - a. At least 4 prenatal check-ups (PNCU) with at least one (1) examination undertaken by the Municipal Health Officer (1 PNCU during the first semester, 1 PNCU during the second semester and 2 PNCU during the 3<sup>rd</sup> semester)
  - b. Given a full course of tetanus toxoid immunization;
  - c. Laboratory tests (CBC, urinalysis, blood typing and Hepa B test);
  - d. Attendance to Information, Education and counseling on safe motherhood, nutrition and child care, family planning, exclusive breastfeeding, Infant Young Child Feeding, National Program on Immunization (NIP), Newborn Screening (NBS).
- 4.2. During prenatal visits, provides counseling on the following:
  - a. Maternal nutrition
  - b. Danger signs of pregnancy
  - c. Birth plan
  - d. Family support
  - e. Newborn care
  - f. Breastfeeding
  - g. Responsible parenting, among others
- 4.3. Only pregnant mothers who give birth to and have undergone at least four (4) prenatal care services in recognized birthing and health facilities be entitled to the benefits of this Ordinance.

#### **SECTION 5. MATERNITY KIT/BUNTIS AND BABY BAG**

Pregnant women who have completed prenatal care services from the Rural Health Unit and/or Barangay Health Stations within the Municipality shall only avail of the Maternity Care Package which shall consist of the following:

FOR THE MOTHER:	FOR BABY"
- 1 pack baby diaper (4 pcs.)	- 1 pc. "pranela"
- 2 adult diapers	- baby dress - 1 short, 1 long
- 1 250 mL alcohol 70%	- 1 pair mittens
- 1 cord clamp	- 1 pair booties
- 5 surgical gloves - size 7	- 1 pc. cap
- 2 ampule oxytocin	- 2 pcs. "lampin"
- 2 syringe - 3 cc	
- 1 syringe - 5 cc	
- 1 pack 10 g cotton	
- 1 60 ml Betadine	
- 1 roll tissue	

**SECTION 6. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS.** The Municipal Mayor shall be responsible in the formulation of the implementing rules and regulations of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 7. FUNDING:** The amount of Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php 50,000.00) shall be taken from the Maternity Care Package of the Philhealth Capitation Fund for the implementation of this program.

**SECTION 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If any provisions of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, other parts or provision that is not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

**SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and availability of fund.
