INSTITUTIONALIZING THE ANNUAL SEARCH FOR THE CLEANEST AND GREENEST BARANGAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LAMUT, IFUGAO AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Municipality of Lamut is hailed as the show window and gateway of the Province of Ifugao. Being tagged as such, the officialdom is looking for ways to promote the municipality's image and its development for the people and as well as people who come to visit and to say that Lamut indeed is the place to be.

Section 16 of the Local Government Code states that a Local Government Unit has the primary obligation to promote health and safety and enhance the right of the people to balance ecology.

One of the program thrusts and policies of the Municipal Government Unit of Lamut is to establish a clean and healthy environment. It is committed to promote programs and activities through strong political will, appropriate legislative measure with firm implementation and community participation through unified efforts and action for the environment.

The establishment and organization of a Clean and Green Contest will encourage the different barangays in the municipality to actively participate in the pursuit and a realization of a Clean and Green Lamut.

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Lamut, Ifugao in session duly assembled:

Section 1. Title. This ordinance shall be known as the "Annual Search for the Cleanest and Greenest Barangay in the Municipality of Lamut and Providing Funds Thereof."

Section 2. Policy Statement. The Local Government Unit of Lamut is committed to establish a clean and healthy environment and to protect, preserve and conserve the ecosystem.

Section 3. Definition of Terms

- a. Barangays - refers to all 18 barangays of Lamut
- b. Material Recovery Facility (MRF) - includes a solid waste transfer station or sorting station, drop-off center, a composting facility and a recycling facility
- c. Biodegradable - refers to organic wastes (e.g. Kitchen waste, vegetable, fruits, flowers, leaves and the like)

Section 4. Coverage. The contest will cover all the barangays in the municipality of Lamut, Ifugao.

Section 5. Criteria. The criteria will be the following:

- a) 25% - for proper garbage segregation and disposal. Waste shall be segregated as basis of biodegradable and non-biodegradable waste
- b) 25% - beautification and cleanliness
- c) 20% - for tree planting activities/gulayan sa barangay
- d) 10% - presence of Barangay Ordinances/Executive Orders supporting the Clean and Green program
- e) 10% - presence of MRF
- f) 10% - documentation

Section 6. Clean and Green Committee - There shall be a Committee created to implement and monitor the Clean and Green Contest and shall determine the winning barangay for the Annual Search for the Cleanest and Greenest Barangay Contest:

Chairman	:	Municipal Mayor
Vice-Chairman	:	Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Officer (MENRO)
Members	:	Municipal Planning and Development Coordinator MLGOO Municipal SK Federation President Municipal Agriculture Officer Representative from Religious Sector Representative from Non-Government Organizations OSCA President Dep-Ed Supervisor
Secretariat	:	SB Secretary

Section 7. The Clean and Green Committee shall also adopt additional measures, rules and regulations that are necessary and reasonable in the implementation of the contest:

Section 8. Incentives/Prizes for Winning Barangay shall be:

- a. First - P50,000.00 and Certificate or Plaque of Recognition
- b. Second - P30,000.00 and Certificate or Plaque of Recognition
- c. Third - P20,000.00 and Certificate or Plaque of Recognition

Section 9. Funding and Appropriation - The amount of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (P150,000.00) shall be appropriated annually from the General Fund of the Municipality.

Section 10. The contest shall start every month of June until March of the following year. Evaluation will be quarterly. The announcement of winners and awarding of prizes shall be during the Rambakan Festival in the month of April.

Section 11. Repealing Clause - All ordinances or parts of any ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 12. Effectivity - This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval and upon compliance with the requirements of the law.
